CAMPGROUND FACILITIES

- 2 playgrounds
- 2 large picnic shelters
- Tennis courts and Basketball court
- Horseshoe pits located next to sand volley ball
- Sand volleyball - First come, first serve. Be courteous to others.
- Municipal Bandshell - Thursday night concerts during the summer. A schedule is posted on park information board.
- Skateboard Park - located on west side of park off Elm Street. Open from 9:00 am - 10:00 pm. Please observe posted safety rules.
- Municipal swimming pool. Hours are from 1:00 pm to 9:00 pm each day except Sunday when pool opens at 1:30 pm. Admission is \$2.00 per day without season pass. Family swim is from 5:00 - 7:00 pm. The pool opens in May and closes prior to school starting in August
- Community Library with internet access one block from campground area. Hours are Mon. through Fri, 10:00 am - 5:00 pm, Sat: 10:00 am - 12:00 noon. Extended evenings on Thursdays until 7:30 pm. The Library is open year round.

CAMPING GUIDELINES

- Camping is permitted only in areas designated.
- Electrical hook-ups are available only to campers registered on an electrical site. Extension cords may not be run from one campsite to another.
- When two units occupy a site, both must pay camping fees. Double-ups may or may not be available at all campsites due to pad lengths or closeness in proximity to other sites. Check with City Hall before doubling any campsite.
- Campsites must be re-registered or vacated by 4pm
- Between May 1 and September 30, the parks close from 11 pm to 6 am. Quiet hours also follow these times. Please consider others in the park at all times. Disturbances caused by loud music or disorderly conduct can lead to expulsion from the park.
- Pets must be on a leash no longer than 10 feet. Pets (except service animals) are not allowed in swimming pool or in any park buildings. Owners must clean up after their pets.
- The speed limit in the park and recreation area is 10 miles per hour. Please be cautious in campgrounds and other busy areas. Be especially alert for children.
- Campfires are allowed only at designated campsites and in approved fireplaces, stoves or grills.
- All types of fireworks are prohibited in the city limits.
- Don't be a litterbug. Please place all garbage in proper receptacles.
- The camping area opens in the spring and closes in the fall as the weather allows. You may call City Hall to inquire if the camping area has been opened.
- All campsites and shelters are first-come, first-served. Lennox accepts reservations beginning January 2 for all arrival dates during the park's upcoming season. Reservations for campsites will not be held without payment. Reserve online at www.cityoflennoxsd.com or call (605) 647-2286.
